**How to Raise a Reader**



**READ TOGETHER**

Choose a book to read together. By reading it together, you have the opportunity to explain more complicated words and expand your child’s reading vocabulary. Starting a conversation around the topic is also beneficial.

**BOOKS EVERYWHERE**

Put books everywhere! If there’s a book on the coffee table, by the dining table, by the bed and in the bathroom, then you provide the temptation for your child to pick them up. Remember to include magazines and Kid Scoop!

**BOOKS OF MOVIES**

So many children’s books are made into movies. Talk about this with your child. Make it a rule to always read the book when you see a movie and take the time to discuss the differences.

**LIBRARY CARDS**

Your local library is a huge resource for children, including everything from author visits and events to storytelling hours. Sign them up for a library card and show them all the different sections of the children’s library.

**START YOUR OWN LIBRARY**
