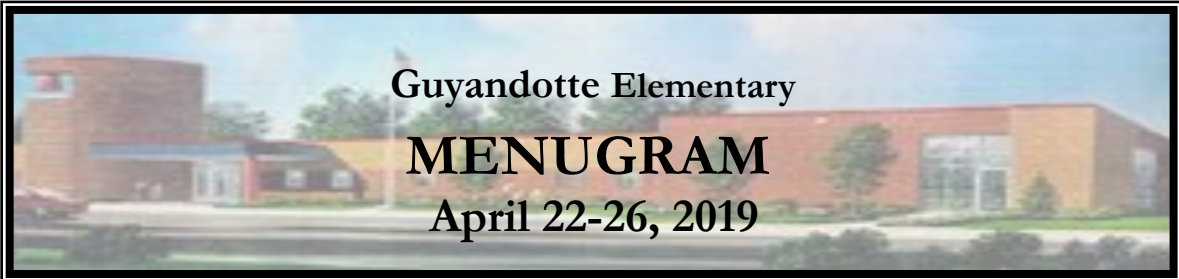

School News

Testing Days:

All students in grades 3-5 in Cabell County are required to take this test. All students across the county will be testing on the following dates:

3rd grade: ELA -April 30, Writing - May 1, and Math May 2

5th grade: ELA- May 7, Writing - May 8, Math - May 9 and Science - May 10

4th grade: ELA - May 14, Writing - May 15, and Math - May 16

*Please note, if your child misses a testing date, a make-up test will be scheduled to ensure we get 100% participation. Please make any appointments so as NOT to interfere with this testing schedule.

To help your child perform at their best, please use the following guidelines:

- Make sure your child arrives to school on time.
- Make sure your child gets a good night's sleep before each school day.
- Breakfast is provided by our school every morning or you can provide a healthy meal for your child.
- Reassure your child this assessment is only one part of school and to do their best. This is only one test and one cannot know everything.
- Listen to all directions and read additional prompts as needed.
- Remind them of tips that teachers have been expressing such as: read the questions first before reading the passages. Use scratch paper to work out math problems. Most questions are multiple choice so eliminate answers. Sometimes you must choose one or more choices that make the most sense. If you don't know, take a guess.
- Stay calm and have a positive mindset. This will help your child stay calm and positive toward the test.
- Remind your child as to how smart he /she is, and you are proud of them! This is the time for your child to show off their skills
